

Chico State Cycling Oroville Dam Race

RAIN or SHINE!!!

Saturday October 22nd

XC RACE: 9:00am -

Same course from our 2007 race. It starts down a fire road, leading to a lollipop loop that is about 3.5 miles long on Potters Ravine Trail. Mostly dual track.

Men's A -5 laps; Women's A, Men's B - 4 laps; Men's C/D, Women's B/C - 3 laps

Since the loops are so short we have to run two cross country races to eliminate excessive passing with all classes.

Men's A/B and Women's A's will race at 9am

Men's C/D, women's B/C: 11am

Super 'D' Race: 2:00pm-

Super D pending on course...

Sunday October 23rd,

Same courses from our 2009 race.

Short Track:

Registration for STXC opens at 7:30am closes at 30 min before start.

9:00 am - this will be a hilly short track and a fast descent from the Super D course on Potters Ravine/ Freeman connector.

Men's A- 30 minutes

Women's A, Men's B - 25 minutes

Men's C/D, Women's B/C- 20 minutes

Each class will start in the above order with 5 minute gaps between each race.

Downhill:

Downhill registration closes at 1:45 pm, no exceptions

2:00 pm - filled with flat turns, high speeds, and rocks on the Brad Freeman Trail.

Descending approximately 1000 feet in a few minutes- this track is fast, 30 second intervals. Start order fastest to slowest.

Per USACYCLING to ride the downhill course you must be wearing a full face helmet.

Do not walk back up the course during the race; use the fire road to ride back up.

DH course open for practice during the XC race on Saturday, but will close promptly following the end to allow the Super D to use a section. DH course will be open for race day practice before and after the short track races.

To Oroville Dam, Oroville, Ca

From Chico to Race Venue:

Take Hwy 99 South

Continue 10 miles

Stay Left on CA 149

CA149 become 70 South

Continue 5 miles

Exit 46 to Oro Dam Blvd

Turn left onto Oro Dam Blvd

Stay on Oro Dam Blvd

Green Line on Road will begin

Turn Left onto Canyon Rd at Stop Sign

Still Following Green Line

Continue on Canyon Rd to Left on Oroville Dam Rd

Follow Oroville Dam Rd. across Dam to Cul de sac Turnout

From South to Race Venue:

From Sacramento take CA 70 north

Exit 46 to Oro Dam Blvd

Turn right onto Oro Dam Blvd

Stay on Oro Dam Blvd

Green Line on Road will begin

Turn Left onto Canyon Rd at Stop Sign

Still Following Green Line

Continue on Canyon Rd to Left on Oroville Dam Rd

Follow Oroville Dam Rd. across Dam to Cul de sac Turnout
